President Irby called the meeting to order at 7:00 PM. And called the roll noting a quorum present and the Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Clerk Toalson was absent and President Irby took notes for the minutes.

Approval of the Minutes of the Regular Meeting of August 31, 2015: Motion by Trustee Garrison, second by Trustee Heintz to approve the minutes as presented. Roll call vote as follows: Garrison, Heintz, King, Vershaw and Hamilton: "Aye". VanDieren: absent. Motion carried.

Approval and Authorization for Payment of Bills: Motion by Trustee King, second by trustee Hamilton to approve the bills as presented. Trustee King questioned paying Vanessa Knox \$60.00 per week to clean the Village Hall. Discussed with no action taken. Trustee Hamilton questioned a payment for a memorial bench. Treasurer Lage explained the expenditure. Roll call vote as follows: King, Hamilton, Vershaw, Garrison and Heintz: "Aye". VanDieren: absent. Motion carried.

Approval of the Treasurer’s Report for the Month Ending August 2015: Motion by Trustee King, second by trustee Vershaw to approve the Treasurer’s Report as presented. Roll call vote as follows: King, Vershaw, Hamilton, Heintz and Garrison: “Aye”. VanDieren: absent. Motion carried.

Consideration and Approval for the Purchase of Replacement Tires for 2 Squad Cars: Motion by Trustee Garrison, second by Trustee Hamilton to approve the purchase of new tires for the squad cars. Roll call vote as follows: Garrison, Hamilton, Vershaw, Heintz and King: “Aye”. VanDieren: absent. Motion carried.

Consideration and Approval of Pay Request #1 from Walter D. Laud for the 2015 MFT Maintenance Project: Motion by Trustee Heintz, second by Trustee Vershaw to approve the pay request in the amount of \$115,329.10 to Walter D. Laud for the MFT Project. Roll call vote as follows: Heintz, Vershaw, Hamilton, King and Garrison: “Aye”. VanDieren: absent. Motion carried.

Consideration and Approval for Purchase of Water Billing Envelopes: Clerk Toalson was not present. This would be a year’s worth of envelopes. Motion by Trustee King, second by Trustee Hamilton to approve the purchase of the envelopes. Roll call vote as follows: King, Hamilton, Vershaw, Heintz and Garrison: “Aye”. VanDieren: absent. Motion carried.

Streets and Alleys: Trustee Heintz asked about the striping of the bike path. Supervisor McKay confirmed that Peterson Parking Lot Striping is supposed to do the work. We are waiting for them.

Parks and Heritage Center: Trustee King discussed the totals for Hampton Days on the Treasurer’s Report. Trustee Vershaw turned in two more checks just today. The balance is in the black.

Public Safety: Trustee Garrison reported that the Taming of the Slough on September 19th went well.
