Message from the President

We made it thru the worst of winter with relative ease. This is really a month of seasonal transition. Our main order of business continues to be budget discussions. State projections of revenue appear to be flat this year, we won't see much for revenue increases. We plan to be very conservative, lucky for us, our needs are not as great as they have been in the last few years. I am pleased that we made upgrades to the buildings and vehicles. Given that we will continue to see economic uncertainty on a state and federal level, we are going to proceed with caution as far as the budget is concerned. We received some very good news on the fire department front. Chief Johnson was able to get a small equipment grant that will allow for some new defibrillators. This will save around \$17,000, I'm told. Also, we should see some of the new fire department trucks going into service this month. It's looking like the new fire engine will be done in August. I will be headed to Springfield at the end of this month to advocate our interests and attend the IML lobby day. Same as last year cities around the state want see a return to full state funding and I am seeking an audience with IDOT.

Enjoy the beginning of spring.
