YARD WASTE PICK UP EXTENDED

Yard waste pick up will be extended a few weeks into November since the leaves are still coming down from the trees. Keep an eye on the Village Facebook page for the cutoff date once it is announced.

As a reminder, leaf and yard waste burning is allowed Wednesday through Saturday* from sunrise to sunset or 8:00 p.m., whichever is later. ***Burning is not allowed on the last Saturday of the month. Burning is prohibited Sunday through Tuesday every week.** All fires must be fully extinguished (no smoldering, smoking or hot embers) by sunset or 8:00 p.m. Burning of non-lawn waste materials of any kind is prohibited, including, but not limited to: garbage, cardboard, construction materials, furniture, tires, etc. A water source must be available at the fire location, the fire must be monitored in-person and be controlled at all times. No embers should travel to any adjacent property. Burning is prohibited on all red-flag and crop fire danger days as determined by the National Weather Service.
