Residents are encouraged to reduce their waste by taking advantage of the recycling program. You do not need to separate your recycling; it can all be mixed together. Please rinse all cans and bottles, and flatten all boxes.

What can always be placed in your recycling cart:



Paper

- ✓ Newspaper
- ✓ Chipboard
- ✓ Office paper
- ✓ Phone books
- ✓ Magazines



Plastic

- ✓ Plastic bottles & containers coded # 1 - #7
- ✓ HDPE plastics



Metal

- ✓ Aluminum
- ✓ Aluminum cans
- ✓ Tin & steel cans



Cardboard

- ✓ Cardboard
- ✓ Boxboard
- ✓ Cereal boxes
- ✓ Shoe boxes
- ✓ Soda & beer carrying cases

What can never be placed in your recycling cart:



- ✗ Disposable diapers
- ✗ Ribbons, foil & wrapping paper
- ✗ Tissues & paper towels
- ✗ Plastic-coated or food-soiled paper
- ✗ Empty motor oil & antifreeze containers
- ✗ Polystyrene foam
- ✗ Polystyrene foam packing peanuts & bubble wrap (reuse or take out of containers)
- ✗ Mirrors, window glass, ceramic dishes, incandescent & halogen bulbs, fluorescent tubes/bulbs
- ✗ Candy wrappers & chip bags
- ✗ Prescription vials
- ✗ Paint containers & aerosol containers that are not empty
- ✗ Sharp or greasy metal
- ✗ Vacuum cleaner bags
- ✗ Cigarette butts
- ✗ Pet waste
- ✗ CDs & CD cases
- ✗ **No plastic bags**

A Message From Republic Services®

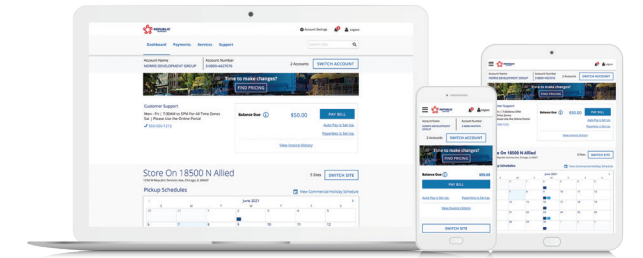
The Village of Hampton has partnered with Republic Services for city-wide recycling and waste collection. While not all-inclusive, this guide is designed to provide you with information on the services.



- Starting **July 7, 2026**, your waste collection will occur every **Tuesday**.
- Recycling collection will occur **every other Tuesday**.
- Republic Services is providing each house with a 95-gallon recycling cart and a 95-gallon trash cart. All material must fit in the carts provided. Material placed outside the carts will not be collected.
- If more carts are needed, they can be ordered through your online account or by contacting **563.332.0050** (for an additional monthly charge).

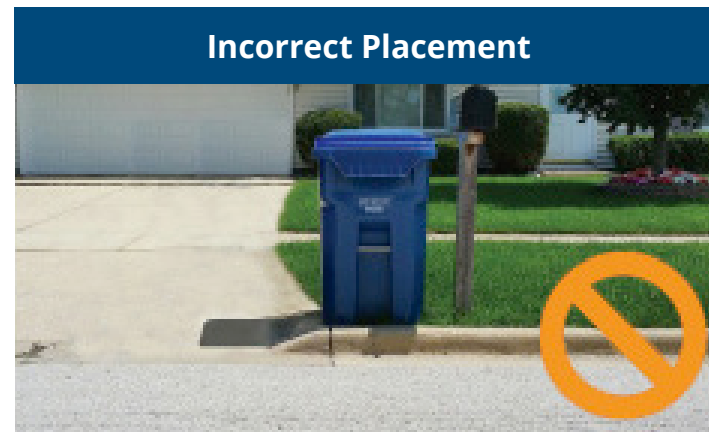


Schedule Services:

Schedule additional pickups, report a missed pickup, or request a repair or replacement cart.

Cart Placement

Please place carts at least 3 feet away from obstructions, such as mailboxes, trees, utility poles, parked cars, other carts or other objects with at least 16 ft. of overhead clearance. Set carts out with the wheels against the curb or at the edge of the alleyway with the handle toward the house.



Additional Services

Yard Waste Collection

Residents will have the option to individually subscribe to a 96-gallon yard waste cart, which will be serviced weekly April through November. Use your online account or call **563.332.0050** to sign up for this service at a rate of \$125 per year. The subscription will stay active until canceled.

Bulk Waste Collection

Residents will be able to dispose of up to 3 bulk items and 1 cubic yard of containerized material during the annual city cleanup. For bulk collection outside of the annual cleanup event, call **563.332.0050** or request service through the app. Additional charges will apply.
