MEETING OF THE BOARD OF TRUSTEES OF THE VILLAGE OF HAMPTON, ILLINOIS August 25, 2025 AT 6:30 PM

President Bornhoeft called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Deputy Clerk Coberley called the roll noting a quorum was present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Meeting was held at the Village Hall.

Approval of the Meeting Minutes of August 11, 2025. Motion to approve the minutes made by Trustee White seconded by Trustee Klouser. Motion passed with Trustees White, Klouser, Culver and Gonzalez voting "Aye". Trustee Adams abstained.

Approval and Authorization for Payment of Bills. Motion to approve payment of bills made by Trustee Adams, seconded by Trustee Gonzalez. Motion approved by roll call vote as follows: Culver, Gonzalez, Adams, Klouser and White: "Aye". Motion carried.

Visitors who Wish to Address the Board (3-minute time limit). No visitors addressed the board.

Tahoe. Motion made by Trustee White and seconded by Trustee Adams. Motion passed with a unanimous vote.

Approval of the adjustment to DeVoss utility bill. Deputy Clerk stated that resident DeVoss, who resides on 8th Avenue in Hampton, was under the impression that he had an irrigation meter at his home and was concerned about the high water bills that he had received. Upon inspection, it was determined that he did not have an irrigation meter at his residence. He asked that the board allow the sewage fees to be removed from portions of the bill since the water didn't go into the sewer. Motion to deny made by Trustee Adams, seconded by Trustee White. Motion approved by unanimous vote.

New Business & Committee Reports

Streets and Alleys: Trustee Culver had nothing to report.

Public Safety: Trustee Johnson was absent.

Sheriff: absent.

Fire Rescue Chief Report: Chief Johnson was absent.

Finance: Trustee Adams reminded the board that we are coming to the end of the fourth month of the new budget and asked them to keep an eye on the budget. She also asked the board to refer to the most recent IML publication regarding tow fees.

Administration, Insurance and Code Enforcement: Trustee Klouser discussed the work being done to update job descriptions. He also indicated that he has spoken with the new owners of the old hardware store about their plans for the building. They plan to do some partial demo and he intends to be there for this work.

Public Works: Trustee White had nothing to report

Public Works Director: Director Toalson reported that they repaired a water main break on 2nd Ave Ct last week. He also stated that the new water valve would be getting installed at the top of 4th St hill on Tuesday August 26, 2025.

Parks and Heritage Center: Trustee Gonzalez discussed the Hampton Days 2025 events. He thanked Walmart and Hy-Vee for the generous donations and volunteers. He also thanked Village employees and sponsors for volunteering and supporting the event.

Village Clerk: Clerk Reyes was absent.

Deputy Clerk: Deputy Clerk Coberley notified the board that the sign ordered for the Heritage Center would be delivered to the Clerk's office this week. She also mentioned that Clerk Reyes was looking into getting Code of Ordinance Violation notices for the deputies to use.

President's Reports and Comments: President Bornhoeft thanked Trustee Gonzalez for his work on Hampton Days 2025. He stated that they are still working on a location for the electric information sign along Rt 84.

Being no further business, Motion by Trustee Adams, second by Trustee White to adjourn. Motion passed by unanimous voice vote. Meeting adjourned at 7:17 PM.
