Approval of the Budget Meeting Minutes of March 23, 2026. Motion to approve the minutes made by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Culver. Motion approved by voice vote: "Aye". Motion carried, Gonzalez absent.

Approval and Authorization for Payment of Bills. Motion to approve payment of bills made by Trustee Adams, seconded by Trustee Johnson. Motion approved by roll call vote as follows: White, Klouser, Culver, Johnson, and Adams: "Aye". Motion carried. Gonzalez absent.

Discussion of FY2026-2027 budget. No changes of the final proposed budget. Final budget meeting with public comment to be held April 20, 2026 at 6:15PM.

Consideration and Approval of the Proclamation recognizing National Bike Month. Motion made by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Johnson to approve the proclamation recognizing national bike month. Motion approved by unanimous voice vote: "Aye". Motion carried. Gonzalez absent.

NEW BUSINESS:

Streets and Alleys: Trustee Culver reported that she spoke with MidAmerican in regard to add lights within the village. There are 24 locations with poles for new lights and 7 without poles. She will reach out to MidAmerican regarding pricing.

Public Safety: Trustee Johnson would like to have ADT give a quote for surveillance.

Sheriff: Deputy stated that everything is going well. The controlled ordinance violations will be held the week after Memorial Day.

Fire Rescue Chief Report: Chief Manion had nothing to report, however, he did receive everything that he ordered.

Finance: Trustee Adams reported to everyone that they need to get their Statement of Economic Interest slips back to clerk. She also wanted to remind trustees to take their OMA training with the State. She also stated that she will continue working on the job descriptions.

Administration, Insurance, and Code Enforcement: Trustee Klouser would like to have a standing agenda item after public comment that addresses concerns that were emailed.

Public Works: Trustee White noticed the new street signs within the village. The new employee did a good job.

Public Works Director: Director Toalson reported that Alex is doing great. They have put up the new picnic tables and benches in the park.

Parks and Heritage Center: Trustee Gonzalez absent.

Village Clerk: Clerk Bergeson reported that the City of East Moline has been overbilling the village since the installation of the main meter. The residents have been properly billed. The city was converting the gallons to cubic meters and thus created an overage. Clerk will send an email to meet with officials.

Deputy Clerk: Deputy Clerk Coberley absent

President's Reports and Comments: President Bornhoeft reported on the installation of the sign. This sign was part of a \$50,000 grant from Representative Gregg Johnson. The sign, installation, survey, and electrical will be covered under this grant. It will not cost the village taxpayers anything. This sign will be used for village business and school events. It will one more way to communicate with the residents.
