President Christopher Bornhoeft called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Deputy Clerk Coberley called the roll noting a quorum was present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Meeting was held at the Village Hall.

Approval of the Meeting Minutes of April 13, 2026. Motion to approve the minutes made by Trustee White seconded by Trustee Adams. Motion rescinded by Trustee Adams. Motion to approve with corrections made by Trustee Klouser, Seconded by Trustee Johnson. Approved with unanimous voice vote.

Approval of the Budget Meeting Minutes of April 20, 2026. Motion to approve made by Trustee Culver, seconded by Trustee Klouser. Motion approved with unanimous voice vote. Motion carried.

Approval and Authorization for Payment of Bills. Motion to approve payment of bills made by Trustee Adams, seconded by Trustee White. Motion approved by roll call vote as follows: Adams, Gonzalez, Johnson, Culver, Klouser, and White: "Aye". Motion carried.

Visitors who wish to address the Board (3-minute time limit). Scott McKay addressed the board regarding the bed and breakfast by his house. He had concerns about safety. The board informed him that he needed to reach out to the police when incidents occurred so that they could be involved.

Elliott Stone spoke about the frequency and noise from the sirens. He was informed that the Village does not control the sirens. Trustee White let him know that NWS and the 911 Board had control over the sirens. He also let him know that those agencies do have meetings which he is welcome to attend and express his concerns.

Discussion, Consideration and Approval to Accept an overpayment from the City of East Moline in the form of a credit. The credit would be applied to water and sewer usage until the balance of the credit has been used. Director Toalson told the Board that getting the overpayment back as a credit towards water and sewer usage would allow him to start the first phase of the repairs needed for the water system infrastructure below the hill.

Discussion of Correspondence from Residents. Trustee Johnson discussed a resident's concerns about the change from Conrad Disposal to Republic. Clerk Coberley told the Board that within the next two weeks, information will be provided through the website, newsletter and Facebook making sure that residents are aware of how the transition will take place with several weeks to prepare before the official change over.

Streets and Alleys: Trustee Culver is waiting for a map of the current layout of streetlights in the Village.

Public Safety: Trustee Johnson nothing to report.

Sheriff: Deputy said that they are addressing the motorbike issues that some residents are having. He also stated that there will be some warnings for ordinance violations, followed by citations for noncompliance.

Fire Rescue Chief Report: Chief Manion talked about a leak that has developed in the roof of the Fire Station. It has been repaired, however he will be looking into a better long-term repair.

Finance: Trustee Adams had nothing to report.

Administration, Insurance, and Code Enforcement: Trustee Klouser is working with residents to locate and address ordinance violations. He would like the residents to be able to discuss their concerns about the violations.

Public Works: Trustee White had nothing to report.

Public Works Director: Director Toalson had nothing to report.

Parks and Heritage Center: Trustee Gonzalez spoke about issues with the pin pad that was installed on the door of the Heritage Center. Clerk Coberley notified him that the pin pad had been repaired earlier that day. He complimented the new benches and tables that were installed in Heritage Park. Trustee Gonzalez also gave a brief update on the Hampton Days event.

Village Clerk: Clerk Bergeson was absent.

Deputy Clerk: Deputy Clerk Coberley said that she will work on getting information posted about the ordinance violation procedure, the Republic change and building permit information to make sure that residents are informed. She stated that the CCR Report for 2025 is complete and the post cards have been mailed out to the residents.

President's Reports and Comments: President Bornhoeft will be meeting with people about the location and installation of the LED sign that the Village got through a grant. He also discussed some ideas for the Village to participate in the 250 Celebration.

Being no further business, motion to adjourn by Trustee Adams, seconded by Trustee Gonzalez. Meeting adjourned at 7:41pm.
