President Christopher Bornhoeft called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Clerk Bergeson called the roll noting a quorum was present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Meeting was held at the Village Hall.

Approval of the Meeting Minutes of July 13, 2026. Motion to approve the minutes made by Trustee White seconded by Trustee Klouser. Approved with unanimous voice vote. Adams and Gonzalez absent.

Approval and Authorization for Payment of Bills. Motion to approve payment of bills made by Trustee Culver, seconded by Trustee Johnson. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Culver, Johnson and Klouser: "Aye". Absent: Adams and Gonzalez. Motion passed.

Visitors who wish to address the Board (3-minute time limit).

*Christina Koch addressed the board regarding the business next door to her, her husband works nights and sleeps during the day, she can still see and hear business.

*Tom McKay addresses the board in regard to a dirt track on 2nd Avenue that is on the right-of-way.

*Al Kipp addressed the board with concerns of the railroad tracks. He has tried to contact them.

Acknowledgment of correspondence from residents. An email from a resident in regard to sewer backup. Director Toalson was in touch with the resident and the situation is handled.

Consideration and Approval of the Resolution to open new banking account for Hampton Days' payments. The village would like to offer the opportunity to accept cards at the Hampton Days event. Clerk's office would like a separate account for these funds to be deposited. Motion made by Trustee Klouser, seconded by Trustee White. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Culver, Johnson and Klouser: "Aye". Absent: Adams and Gonzalez. Motion passed.

Discussion, Consideration and Approval of amending the Purchasing Policy. Discussion as follows: Illinois DOT does not require multiple bids if the work is under the \$25,000 threshold. Director Toalson would like to follow the IDOT policy. Trustee Klouser would like the policy to read "anything over \$2,000 must be brought to board for approval," Motion made by Trustee Klouser, second by Trustee Johnson. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Culver, Johnson and Klouser: "Aye". Absent: Adams and Gonzalez. Motion passed.

Discussion, Consideration and Approval of amendments to the Public Works Director job description. Motion made by Trustee Culver to amend the job description to match the Purchasing Policy, seconded by Trustee White. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Culver, Johnson and Klouser: "Aye". Consideration and Approval of the quote from Lee's Superior Coatings to repair the roofing at the Fire Station. Motion to approve by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Johnson to approve Lee's to fix the roofing. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Culver, Johnson and Klouser: "Aye". Absent: Adams and Gonzalez. Motion passed.

Consideration and Approval to purchase pressure washer for the Fire Department. Motion to approve by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Culver. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Culver, Johnson and Klouser: "Aye". Absent: Adams and Gonzalez. Motion passed.

Consideration and Approval of Ordinance 2026-06 an Ordinance Amending Ch. 42 entitled "Traffic and Vehicles. Trustee White made a motion to approve Ordinance 2026-06, seconded by Trustee Johnson. Motion was made by Trustee Johnson and Trustee Culver to rescind the motion to approve and bring back to the next meeting. Motion approved by voice vote.
