President Christopher Bornhoeft called the meeting to order at 6:30 PM. Deputy Clerk Coberley called the roll noting a quorum was present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited. Meeting was held at the Village Hall.

Approval of the Meeting Minutes of July 27, 2026. Motion to approve the minutes made by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Klouser. Motion to rescind by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Klouser for correction. Motion made to approve with correction made by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Klouser. Approved with unanimous voice vote. Trustees Culver and Johnson were absent. Trustee Adams abstained.

Approval and Authorization for Payment of Bills. Motion to approve payment of bills made by Trustee Adams, seconded by Trustee Gonzalez. Motion approved by roll call vote: White, Gonzalez, Adams and Klouser: "Aye". Absent: Culver and Johnson. Motion passed.

Visitors who wish to address the Board (3-minute time limit). Mrs. Reamy addressed the board with safety concerns around the disc golf course at Heritage Park.

Acknowledgment of correspondence from residents. Trustee Klouser said that he had spoken with Mrs. Reamy about the disc golf.

Discussion, Consideration and Approval of the quote received for the culvert repairs in Heritage Center. Motion made by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Adams to approve the quote from McClintock in the amount of \$12,860. Roll call vote as follows: Adams, Gonzalez, Klouser and White all "Aye". Trustees Culver and Johnson absent. Motion approved.

Consideration and Approval of AN ORDINANCE 2026-27 AMENDING CHAPTER 46, ENTITLED "ZONING," OF THE CODE OF ORDINANCES, 46.36 RECREATION AND DIRT BIKE REGULATION VILLAGE OF HAMPTON, ILLINOIS, VLLAGE OF HAMPTON. Motion by Trustee White, seconded by Trustee Adams. Motion passed with roll call vote as follows: Adams, Gonzalez, Klouser and White all "Aye". Trustees Culver and Johnson absent.

Consideration and Approval of Ordinance 2026-06 an Ordinance Amending Ch 42 entitled "Traffic and Vehicles". Motion made by Trustee Klouser, seconded by Trustee Gonzalez. Motion passed with roll call vote as follows: Adams, Klouser, Gonzalez and White all "Aye". Trustees Culver and Johnson absent.

Streets and Alleys: Trustee Culver absent. Trustee Klouser said that he will be looking to get maps of areas that need additional streetlights. Director Toalson stated that the concrete work on the roads is scheduled to begin the week of August 24th and blacktop will be getting done as weather permits.

Public Safety: Trustee Johnson contacted the railroad again about getting lights installed at the railroad crossings. He was instructed to contact the DOT.

Sheriff: Deputy had nothing to report.

Fire Rescue Chief Report: Chief Manion was absent.

Finance: Trustee Adams reminded everyone that we just finished the first quarter of the fiscal year and continue to watch spending.

Administration, Insurance, and Code Enforcement: Trustee Klouser had nothing to report.

Public Works: Trustee White nothing to report.

Public Works Director: Director Toalson stated that he will work with the board to develop a backup plan if there is a temporary water supply issue in the future.

Parks and Heritage Center: Trustee Gonzalez gave an update on the preparations for Hampton Days 2026.

Village Clerk: Clerk Bergeson was absent.

Deputy Clerk: Deputy Coberley reminded the trustees about selling tickets for the Hampton Days raffle. She also mentioned the IML Conference coming up in September.

President's Reports and Comments: President Bornhoeft thanked the Sheriff's department for the National Night Out last week. He also read a notification from Representative Johnson's office awarding the Village a \$250,000 state grant for new playground equipment at Heritage Park.
